dowers that future strife may be prevented now the princes france and burgundy great rivals in our youngest daughter s love long in our court have made their amorous sojourn and here are to be answer d tell me my daughters since now we will divest us both of rule interest of territory cares of state which of you shall we say doth love us most that we our largest bounty may extend where nature doth with merit challenge goneril our eldest born speak first
