

and the odyssey as poetry therefore the author has tried to give some account of the nature of oral poetry to help the reader formulate an aesthetic different from that which he would employ for literate poetry moreover the author has discussed some of the common techniques of oral epic narration so that the reader may more easily notice when homer is using these often routine devices for effects that are especially pertinent to his poem from preface
